EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROCEDURES

<u>Evacuate</u>

<u>Lockdown</u>

- If the fire alarm sounds or you are notified by an official, evacuate using the nearest exit or alternative if nearest exit is not safe.
- If safe to do so assist others, especially the disabled.
- Alert emergency personnel of the location of people still in the building and those unaccounted for.
- Do not return to the building until emergency personnel has cleared it for re-entry.

- Stay out of line of sight of windows and doors.
- Close and lock doors and windows (if it is safe to do so).
- If it is safe to do so, barricade doors.
 - Cover doors and window (close blinds).
- Turn off room or office lights and <u>remain quiet</u>. If you have a cell phone, silence it completely (this means no vibrate mode).
- Faculty, Staff and Midshipmen who are outside must move quickly to a safe space/room and follow these lockdown procedures.
 - Stay in place until emergency personnel notify you that it's safe to leave.

Shelter-in-Place

- Get indoors—shut and lock all doors and windows. Stay away from doors and windows.
- Faculty members who are conducting class should remain in their classroom.
- If the Shelter-in-Place order or requirement is related to air contamination, shutdown air conditioning and heating units if you have the ability to.
- Stay in place until Academy officials or emergency officials notify you that it is safe to leave.

Active Shooter/Terrorism

- If you hear or see a person with a weapon, find a safe haven.
- Initiate LOCKDOWN procedures. Get down on the floor and ensure that no one is visible from outside the room.
- Silence cell phone, including vibrate.
- Call Public Safety **516.726.5911**.
- **DO NOT** stay in open hallways.
- **DO NOT** activate a fire alarm. Evacuation could put building occupants in harms way.
- If you can do so safely, alert the authorities of the location of the shooter.
- Follow instruction from emergency personnel.
- Keep your hands empty and in plain view at all times for police officers.

Bomb Threat

- If determined that an evacuation is necessary,
 EVACUATE the building.
- DO NOT use cellphones or radios .
- Report any unusual observations to emergency personnel.
- Report to Public Safety as soon as possible at 516-726-5911.

EMERGENCIES

Carbon Monoxide

- Open all windows and doors.
- EVACUATE the building immediately and go outside for fresh air.
- If it is safe to do so, assist others in need of help.
- Advise others not to enter the building.
- Call Public Safety as soon as you can at 516-726-5911.

<u>Fire</u>

- Alert others in the area, pull fire alarm, and EVACUATE. DO NOT use elevators.
- Close doors and windows as you leave—DO NOT lock!
- Feel closed doors with back of hand. DO NOT open if doors are hot.
- Move far away from the building once evacuated.
- Report to Public Safety at **516-726-5911**.

Gas Leak/Fumes

- Immediately EVACUATE. DO NOT use elevators.
- DO NOT turn anything on or create any type of spark. DO NOT use or turn on a cellular phone.
- If you can, open all windows.
- Report to Public Safety at **516-726-5911**.
- Stay far away from building.

Hazardous Materials

- Move away from the hazard to a safe location.
- If an emergency or if anyone is in danger, call Public Safety.
- Alert others to stay clear of the area.
- Alert emergency personnel if you have been exposed.
- If this is a non-emergency, call 516-726-5909.

Severe Weather Threat

- Seek shelter to Shelter-in-Place.
- Stay away from windows, close doors.
- Move to interior room/hallway on the lowest floor.
- Remain in safe area until danger has passed.

Suspicious Package

- Do not touch or disturb object.
- Call Public Safety—provide the location and description of the package/object.
- Notify your supervisor or commanding officer.
- If told to EVACUATE, look around for anything suspicious to report to authorities.
